Description

All foreign language courses are designed to develop the language proficiency through the use of listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Additionally, students will examine the target cultures to develop a cross-cultural understanding and appreciation.

Expectations

- Be where you are supposed to be, when you are supposed to be there.
 - Be in your seat when the bell rings
 - Be in your seat during class unless directed to do otherwise by the instructor
 - Be in your seat until the instructor dismisses class
- Say when you are supposed to say, when you are supposed to say it.
 - During Spanish class **ALL** students will be expected to communicate in Spanish
 - Students must receive permission to speak in English
 - Any student who does not receive permission may not communicate in English, failure to do so will result in a grade deduction

 - Come to class with a positive, ready to learn attitude
 - Be willing to participate in class
 - Bring **ALL** materials and assignments to class daily
 - All students are expected to follow all classroom expectations at all times, failure to do so will result in disciplinary action:
 - 1st a warning
 - 2nd loss of participation point *or* parental notification
 - 3rd dismissal from class and parental notification to schedule a conference
